

# ANDOVER RIDER TRAINING – CBT AND DAS TRAINING – DSA APPROVED

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Confirming a course automatically assumes acceptance of the terms and conditions of Andover Rider Training.
- 2) All course fees and motorcycle test fees are due in full on or prior to the first day of training. If for any reason, you are unable to attend and need to cancel or change the date of training, a minimum of 7 days notice is required. If the above notice period is not given a loss of course fee will be incurred. Please note that once any part of any course has started, a refund will not be given and all courses need to be completed within six months. After this period a loss of course fees will be incurred.
- 3) Failure to produce a valid licence and relevant documents on the first day of training will result in Andover Rider Training having to cancel your course and your fees will be lost. So, to avoid that happening you must make sure that you have the following with you:  
**CBT** – a valid UK licence (both parts) for the category of motorcycle /moped you have booked to train on. If you hold a photo card licence you must also bring the paper part.  
**After CBT to Test** – a valid UK licence (both parts) for the category of motorcycle /moped you will be training on. CBT Certificate (DL 196) and Theory Test pass certificate (This certificate necessary for road test candidates only). . If you hold a photo card licence you must also bring the paper part.  
**Refresher and Advanced Training** - a valid UK licence (both parts) for the category of motorcycle /moped you have booked to train on. If you hold a photo card licence you must also bring the paper part.
- 4) If your vision needs correcting and you wear glasses or contact lenses it is essential that you wear these for all of your training and your test. You must be able to read a number plate at a minimum distance of 20.5m. Your eyesight will be tested and a failure will result in cancellation of training on the day and a loss of course fees. In the case of your practical motorcycle test, a fail will be recorded. It is the responsibility of all students to ensure that this requirement is met prior to commencement of the booked training course.
- 5) If you are using your own motorcycle or moped for the training and/ or test rather than one supplied by Andover Rider Training, it is your responsibility to ensure that the machine has a valid MOT certificate (if it is over 3 years old), is taxed and insured. It must have a full size 'L' plate displayed front and back. Your machine must be legal for your type of licence, be roadworthy and mechanically sound. If you are in any doubt about any of the above, please call us with any questions prior to training. Unfortunately, if you arrive and your machine does not meet the above criteria, you will lose your training fees.
- 6) Should there be any minor damage to Andover Rider Training's machine during your training, you will be liable for the first £200 of repair costs (at the discretion of Andover Rider Training)
- 7) In the event that the damage to Andover Rider Training's machine is serious, such as a total write off, then you will be liable for the total cost of repairing or replacing the machine in question.
- 8) Andover Rider Training will at all times endeavour to ensure that your training is as enjoyable and as safe as possible. With this in mind, we ask you to comply with the following:
  - a. – you must ensure that you are fit to train, both physically and mentally
  - b. – you must not be over tired or suffering from any illness or injury which may affect your ability to ride
  - c. – you must not have taken recently or be taking any medication which is adverse to operating machinery (check the packet or with your doctor/pharmacist)
  - d. – It is essential that you are within the legal alcohol limit and not under the influence of recreational drugs before arriving for training. If this is not the case, we will refuse training on the day and all course fees will be lost.
- 9) All courses are booked on the basis of the information you have given us. Responsibility for ensuring that these details are correct remains with you. Failure to comply with legal or course requirements as specified will result in loss of course fees.
- 10) All courses are to be completed within six months of commencement.
